Spokane's economy is well-rounded and diversified with a strong emphasis on aerospace, life sciences and healthcare. With more than 120 aerospace industry-related organizations, Spokane has the #5 largest aerospace presence in the nation. Healthcare is another important industry with over a fifth of Spokane residents working in hospitals. The region is expected to grow rapidly in the life sciences sector with the cost of doing business approximately 18% less than the national average. Agriculture also remains important to eastern Washington with Spokane County having over 2,500 farms – the second highest in the state of Washington.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Aug '23 - The aerospace consortium has backed a proposal led by Gonzaga University to house a federal tech hub in Spokane. The construction of the aerospace composites manufacturing center would be aided by the federal Tech Hubs program, which is utilizing a \$10 million budget to designate at least 20 regional hubs across the country and promises to create high-paying jobs.

Trevor Devaney, President of Hi-Rel, believes opportunities like the Artemis mission will continue to draw the aerospace industry to the state of Washington and Spokane, ultimately translating into high paying jobs and further economic stimulus. Washington's aerospace economy currently sustains more than 13,000 jobs and generates more than \$4.6 billion in economic impact.
